Redvale moves into next stage of approvals

WM New Zealand's proposal to extend Redvale Landfill has been accepted into the Government's Fast-track approvals process, marking the start of the next stage of assessment.

For more than 35 years, Redvale has been the main disposal point for much of Auckland's waste. It continues to play an important role in keeping the region's waste system working day to day.

The current consent for Redvale allows landfilling until the end of 2028. After that, Auckland will still need a safe and reliable way to manage its waste.

Auckland Regional Landfill is intended to be the long-term solution. It has been in planning for many years and received resource consent in 2021. However, it is still before the courts and will not be ready in time to replace Redvale.

That creates a gap. Extending Redvale is currently the most practical way to manage that period and maintain continuity for Auckland's waste services. The extension is proposed through to 2036, or earlier if Auckland Regional Landfill is ready to receive all waste streams before then.

For the Dairy Flat community, this means the project will now go through a more detailed process. This includes further technical assessments and input from iwi, Auckland Council and others before any final decision is made.

WM has said it will continue working with local residents, iwi and stakeholders as the process progresses, sharing information and providing opportunities to stay informed and involved.

Independent testing confirms no health risk for Dairy Flat community

Independent testing of water, air and soil around Redvale Landfill has found no evidence of health risks for Dairy Flat School, nearby homes or the wider community.

The testing was commissioned to provide clear, science-based information for local families. It was carried out by accredited laboratories using recognised New Zealand and international standards.

At Dairy Flat School, drinking water was tested over several months. No E. coli was detected, and all metals were well below national and international limits. The water meets all safety standards.

Air quality was also tested at a nearby property and along the landfill boundary. Dust levels were low and consistent with normal semi-rural conditions, even during dry and windy weather designed to test worst-case scenarios. Airborne fibre testing also showed extremely low levels, well below reporting thresholds.

Soil samples taken around the landfill boundary found no asbestos, no BTEX compounds, and metal levels well within Ministry for the Environment standards.

Taken together, the results are clear. Water, air and soil quality are all within normal background ranges and do not pose a risk to health.

WM will continue monitoring at the school and around the site, with further testing planned to provide ongoing transparency and reassurance for the community. Auckland Council is also carrying out testing as another layer of assurance.

Doing it right, every time

John Hansen has been part of the team at Rosedale Transfer Station for just under four years. For him, it's about working with good people and doing the job properly.

What happens at sites like Rosedale directly affects how much waste ends up at landfill, including Redvale.

John had originally taken a role elsewhere but soon realised it was not the right fit. After being introduced to Operations Supervisor Peter Lockie, things clicked straight away.

"I knew pretty quickly this was where I wanted to be," John says.



Rosedale is a tight site that runs hard. Daily volumes have grown significantly, with up to 18 bulk haulage trucks moving through each day. The team relies on preparation, pace and clear communication to keep things moving.

Some trucks are turned around in as little as 10 to 15 minutes.

"You could just push it through and not think about it," John says. "But that's not what we're here for. It's about doing it fast but doing it right."

Recovering more before it reaches landfill

One of the biggest changes in recent years has been how much material is recovered before reaching landfill.

At Rosedale, more is now separated from mixed loads, including steel and other recoverable items. This means less waste going to sites like Redvale and more materials being reused.

"I'm always looking," John says. "If there's something that can be pulled out, we'll get it separated."

This work helps reduce pressure on landfill capacity while supporting a more circular system.

A team that keeps things moving

John credits the site's success to teamwork. Communication is constant, especially during busy periods, with operators using radio to manage traffic and maintain safe conditions.

Even during recent trials, when space was tighter, the team adapted and kept things running smoothly.

It is a small group that takes real ownership of the work.

"We've worked hard to get the right mix of people," Peter says. "Everyone looks out for each other and takes pride in what they do."

Recognition that reflects the team

At the 2026 WM Awards, John was named Operator of the Year. He is quick to share the recognition.

"We're doing well here because everyone pulls together."

Still enjoying the job

At 65, John is not slowing down. He still enjoys being part of a busy, high-performing team.

"It's a pleasure," he says. "Every day's different. It keeps you on your toes."

Dairy Flat Community Trust AGM – July 2026

- **Tertiary** – assisting students undertaking further education or training

Local Board update – May ‘26

It was great to hear from Pest Free Dairy Flat and Friends of Green Road at our April business meeting. Nothing beats face to face engagement to understand the priorities our community has. We are fortunate to have so many dedicated volunteers making our public spaces better for all to enjoy.

Thanks to those of you who provided feedback to the Council budget. 970 of more than 12000 submissions came from Rodney. Having concerns about the proposed rate increases and current priorities on record helps us make informed submissions on your behalf. We have just approved the Draft Local Board plan for consultation between 23 June-23 July – this is Rodney specific and is an aspirational blueprint for the next 3 years. It is where we ask residents whether the budgets we are proposing have the right balance between the Natural Environment, Transport, Built environment (Community facilities like Art Centres and events), and Economic development. It is your opportunity to support the proposal or suggest changes if you don't think the balance is right. With our growing population and new urban centres, the character of Rodney is changing, and we need to ensure we invest in things we value like our environment and invest to fill gaps where things are missing like playgrounds, bike tracks and sports fields.

The Mill Flat bridge project is finally nearing completion - it is due to be finished in June. In mid-May Kahikatea Flats Road will be closing adjacent to #180 for the slip repair. Unfortunately, this will mean a total closure either side of the slip for a few months to allow the repair crew to work. I will share details on FB when the dates are confirmed.

Replanting after Weeds



Hello neighbours and friends

At last the sun has returned after the wet summer. It has, however, been a remarkably good growing season with plenty of water and warmth. Fruit trees are loaded and trees have produced a huge quantity of seed. Unfortunately, the same success applies to our weeds, many of which dominate the hedgerows and fencelines around Dairy Flat and Waitoki.

'What weeds?' many people ask. Let's take a look...

Well, what exactly is a weed? And why do we need to get rid of them?

I guess it could be loosely defined as anything that grows where we don't want it. That's not quite what we mean here. You've all heard of John Key's quest for a Pest Free 2050. The objective of that is to get rid of predator species - possums, rats, stoats etc. And if we achieve that, native birds will return to our backyards, right? Well, not quite. When we get the birds back, they still need somewhere to rest, feed and breed in safety. What do they need for that? They need native plants and trees, not exotic species.

So how big is our local weed problem? It's HUGE

Which weeds do you think might be the worst? Gorse? Ginger? Woolly nightshade? All bad but probably not the worst by a long way. Privet usually goes unnoticed. In spring, the hedges and berms across the area are white with blossom. Very pretty. Unfortunately, privet is one of our most invasive species. Here are the facts:

- Grows upto 15 metres and can live 100 years.
- A mature tree privet can produce upto 1,000,000 seeds per year!
- The seeds attract blackbirds, which fly 3-4 kilometres in any direction. They kindly distribute the seeds wherever they rest, along with little packets of fertiliser. Bird poop.
- Privet seedlings grow fast - over a metre per year, so that they outcompete pretty much every native plant. They are everywhere and spreading fast.

How many of you keep finding privet seedlings in their gardens - despite there being none in the immediate neighborhood? Now you know why.

If you have any of these weeds on your block, please, please get rid of them and if you don't know how to, then contact us.

Our current projects will help:

1. The Rangitopuni Stream Reserve

By the time you read this, we will have planted 1100 trees in the first stage of restoring this piece of neglected reserve between Landfill Access and Richards Road. More will follow. Clearing it has taken many hours of commitment, clearing mainly? Yes, you guessed it: privet.

1. The Dairy Flat Village Hall Reserve

500 seedlings to be planted on Sunday 14th June at 10am. Come and join the fun. Tools and BBQ provided.

985 seedlings planted by Dairy Flat School children and parents. The school works with the Trees for Survival charity, which teaches kids how to grow and care for native plants. These plants are raised at the school and then planted out at a selected site by the same children, who grow them. Cool eh! On 1st May, the seedlings were planted out at a site prepared by Pest Free Dairy Flat and Waitoki, which will continue to nurture the plants and see them healthily established.

1435 seedlings planted by community members plus the Air & Navy Cadets based in Dairy Flat. Fabulous weather again for planting and we were all done in 3 hours...apart from the BBQ! Once again, the site had been cleared by PFD&W members over the previous 6 months. Fantastic collaboration with Auckland Council ranger Dan. Faster response to odour concerns Text: 8601

If you notice an odour from Redvale Landfill and Energy Park, there's now a simple and much faster way to let us know.

You can text 8601 with details regarding odour, and our Environmental Analyst will be notified straight away. We'll begin an investigation within 30 minutes – usually much faster. Our Investigations are more effective when given as much information as possible – location, time, character, intensity, and frequency.

This new system ensures your messages are never delayed and allows us to respond quickly every time. We'll check what's happening on site, visit the property where the odour has been reported, and work with our operations team to take any action needed.

The Redvale team work hard every day to manage Auckland's waste safely and sustainably, and odour control is a key part of this. Some of the measures in place include daily cover, odour-neutralising sprays, and keeping the exposed working face of the landfill as small as possible.

We appreciate your support as we continue to invest in systems that protect our local environment and community.

VDI scale for reporting an odour complaint.

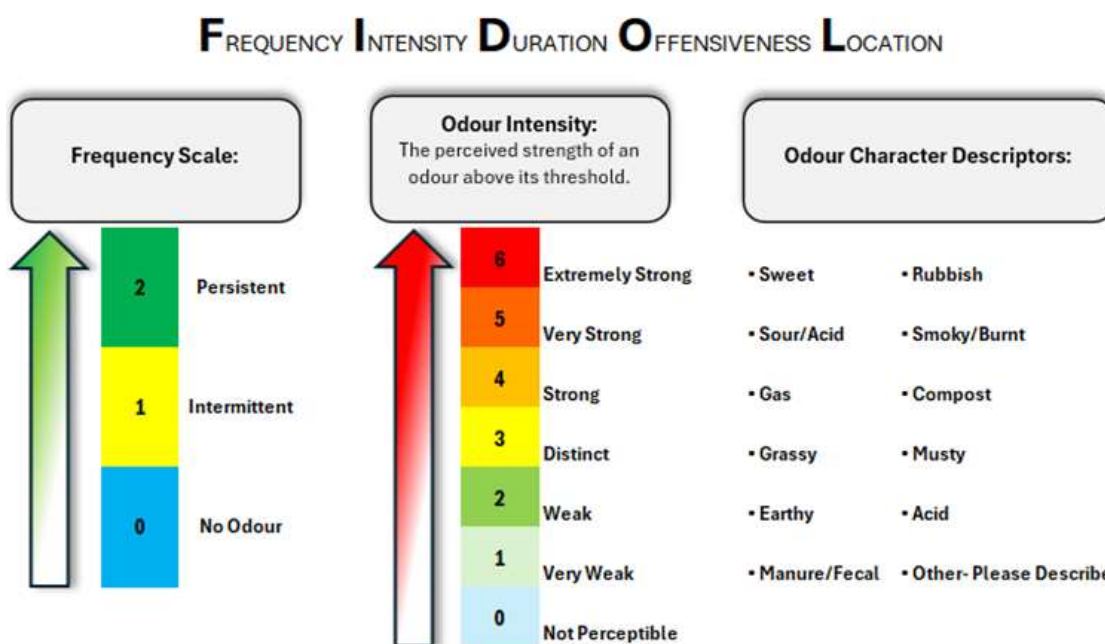
Feedback or Odour complaints can be reported to Redvale Landfill through four different methods,

1. Email: redvalecomplaints@wm.nz
2. Phone call: 09 427 0600
3. Text message: **8601 (New)**
4. Redvale Energy Park Community Liaison website

To work with us, please provide constructive feedback only, which includes the following information,

1. Time and location of the odour
2. Type of the odour
3. Character and intensity of the odour (descriptor + VDI number)
4. Frequency of the odour – how often it occurs, duration of the odour and time of exposure.

(Example Text: Hi there, 3/6 intermittent rubbish odour at XX Tender Road right now.)

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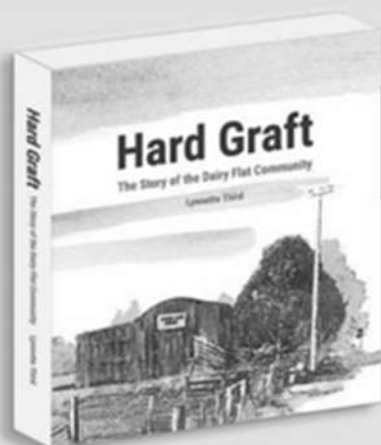
