To work with us, please provide constructive feedback only, which includes the following information,

1. Time and location of the odour
2. Type of the odour
3. Character and intensity of the odour
4. Frequency of the odour – how often it occurs, duration of the odour and time of exposure.

VDI scale example below on how to classify odour intensity.


The best way of assessing odour is via the human nose. But everyone reacts to odours differently. One person may object strongly to an odour while another is not bothered by it. The only objective method to assess odours is a calibrated nose that has completed Olfactometric measurement.

Odour Intensity



Odour Intensity: The perceived strength of an odour above its threshold. It is determined by an odour panel and is described in categories that progress from "Not perceptible"; "Very Weak"; "Weak"; "Distinct", "Strong", "Very Strong", to "Extremely Strong".

Frequency Scale



Odour frequency: The perceived duration of time or exposure experienced.

Let's talk about what's next for Redvale

With Redvale Landfill currently set to stop landfilling in 2028, we're now asking for community feedback on how we manage Auckland's waste during the years before its long-term replacement, Auckland Regional Landfill, is ready.

As part of this, one option being considered, and currently seen as the most workable by WM management, is to apply for a new consent to keep using Redvale for a few more years. I want to acknowledge that this won't be welcome news for everyone. Many locals have lived alongside this facility for a long time, and we know some expected it to wind down in 2028.

That's why we're being upfront about where things stand, and why we're inviting people in the community to have their say now before the WM Board makes its decision on the path forward.

We're holding a community hui at Dairy Flat Community Hall on Wednesday 13 August, from 6.30pm. There'll be a short presentation, time for questions, and the opportunity to speak directly with the team. For those who prefer to talk one-on-one, we've also engaged an independent consultant who'll be available for private conversations during the evening, and by appointment throughout the consultation period.

We're also hosting four online drop-in sessions between now and 25 August, which are open to everyone. You can find the full schedule and session links at www.wm.nz/consultation.

If Redvale continues operating as a landfill beyond 2028, it would only be for a limited time, and we're committed to ensuring the community sees tangible benefits in return. Proposed betterment activity would see annual contributions tied to the volume of waste received, supporting local priorities.

This is your place. We're here to listen, and we want to get this right. Submissions are open until 25 August.

Hi All,

Death and taxes (and their inevitability) are recorded as first used by Daniel Defoe in 1726.

I start this newsletter (written mid-July) with this often-quoted pairing of words as there is yet another word which is inevitable and that is the word **“Change”**.

As a reader, a potential **“change”** is the format in which you receive this newsletter to date, it has always been a printed newsletter but there are moves to put it entirely online or, possibly an abbreviated version circulated in print on a quarterly basis and a full, unabridged version on the Waste Management website. Another option would be one print version per annum to coincide with the notice about the next Dairy Flat Community Trust AGM and the other three copies on a quarterly basis online only. Waste Management has been asked to provide metrics in terms of how many times copies of newsletters are accessed online and that data may well help guide how this newsletter changes as we move into the future.

By the time this newsletter ends in your mailbox or is viewable online, Waste Management will have released their second consultation document (due out 28 July) and hopefully, the press doesn't distort facts again by alluding to a waste crisis and/or extensions of Redvale Landfill through to 2036.

However, as a reader of this newsletter you do need to know that there is **change** coming and it could be in the form of an extension, or a rebalancing of Waste Management's share of the waste market and them diverting more waste to Redvale (from Whitford) through to the end of 2028. Another version could be getting immediate neighbour buy-in (or those falling within a certain distance from the fill) to allow Waste Management to extend the Redvale landfill for up to 8 more years, commencing 1 January 2029. Waste Management is proposing creating a betterment fund which is then spent on improving the surrounding neighbourhood.

Although the application to build a new landfill at Wayby Valley (Dome Valley vicinity) was approved by Auckland Council in 2021, various parties opposing the fill have taken the decision to the Environment Court and to the Court of Appeals and there is still the potential to take the matter to the Supreme Court, meaning Wayby is in no position to come on stream just yet and hence Waste Management needing to find solutions that will hopefully result in win-win situations for them and their neighbours (as well as for their customers and the Auckland rate payer).

I understand that there will be a public meeting at the Dairy Flat Hall on Wednesday 13 August from 6:30pm to discuss various options and encourage all immediate residents to the landfill to come and hear what changes are being proposed and what changes you think would work best. An online feedback portal and an independent facilitator will also be available and again, your chance to have a say!

Update from Louise Johnston: Rodney Local Board Dairy Flat subdivision.

After all the rain this month it is great to see the sun shining and the paddocks finally drying out. This is my last article, as your local board representative. I have put my heart into this role, and I just wanted to say a big thank you for giving me this opportunity. This has been the most fulfilling job that I have ever had. But after nine years it is time to finish up. We are very lucky that there are some great candidates standing in the local election, for the Dairy Flat subdivision. So please make sure you get out and vote! The voter turnout is always very low but Local Boards now have extra powers to sell assets and set budgets, so it more important than ever to vote!

Upcoming proposed changes to Future Urban Zone in Dairy Flat:

Over the last nine years, Dairy Flat locals have had to navigate the rezoning of much of the land to Future Urban, and while property owners initially welcomed this change with a surge in property prices, Future Urban has resulted in land banking and popup industrial yards. While we all want infrastructure delivered in line with growth, thousands of landowners in Dairy Flat now have a Notice of Requirement for future roading projects on their property titles. These future roading projects are unfunded and with Council pushing out the dates for when Dairy Flat is to be urbanised until 2050, it is a massive burden for these residents to have these NORs on their titles for 30 years. However, with the sweeping changes that the Government is proposing with the RMA reform, things may change very quickly. Firstly, is the proposal to remove the Rural Urban Boundary so that effectively means that urbanisation could happen anywhere in the rural zone. Secondly, is that the Government proposes to strengthen the requirements for councils to be responsive to unanticipated or out-of-sequence development proposals. This RMA reform is complex, but the other change that will interest Dairy Flat residents is that waste disposal infrastructure (i.e. landfills) is proposed to be included in the definition of infrastructure. Under the current RMA legislation this is not the case. I am not sure what this means for future resource consent applications for Landfills, but I assume it will make them easier for Waste Companies to get consent.

Also, within the Future Urban Zone, the Surf Park in Dairy Flat have recently applied for Fast-Track consent for 400 dwellings to be included in the Surf Park Precinct. This application is yet to be assessed by the Fast Track panel which will happen later in 2025. If you have any comment or concerns with this application, please let me know and we can include in our Local Board feedback.

Summary of the last 9 years:

Finally, I just wanted to reflect on the last 9 years and highlight some of our successes we have had for Dairy Flat. Firstly, the construction of the roundabout at the intersection of Coatesville Riverhead and Dairy Flat Highway (DFH). Prior to this roundabout, this intersection was one of the most dangerous in New Zealand, it was thanks to the advocacy from the local community that we were able to push for this to be delivered. This was a massive project, that cost 11 million dollars with much of the cost being below ground with the piling etc. Its resilience was definitely tested during the 2023 severe weather events.

Secondly, following the 2018, 2000 signature petition that we presented to Auckland Transport (AT) to lower the speed limit on DFH from 100 to 80km/hr. I really did think we were up for a fight with AT on this one, but AT totally agreed! The speed limit was swiftly lowered, safety improvements installed along the highway including a right-hand turning bay installed on DFH into Bawden Road, a wire rope barrier installed along DFH from Potters Road. DFH has finally lost its nickname of the Deadly Flat Highway. It is hard to believe that the intersection at Kahikatea Flat Road and DFH was once 100km/hr. It needs a roundabout now and this would be a good project for the new Local Board member to get behind.

Also, we now have a pathway connecting Dairy Flat school to the tennis courts and local hall we just needed it extended to the Green Road Park and Dairy Flat village.

Lastly, our 154-hectare park at Green Road. The local community totally got behind this project, the park is now a vested reserve, we have a car park and community access. Two bridges and some of the gravel paths will be delivered this financial year, the Penlink environmental offset planting and fencing will also start later this year. Next financial year, we should have the toilet and bore constructed. We will still need to secure funding for the remainder of the extensive pathway network, but we are making progress. This is the largest neighbourhood park in Auckland and an asset that we can all be proud of.

RIVERHEAD TOASTMASTERS meets fortnightly at Riverhead Hall

Hello neighbours and friends!


Wow! It's been a wet winter so far with around 500mm, that's *twice our average rainfall* in April to June. Local streams are running fast to keep up and there's been plenty of erosion, as well as a few slips across Dairy Flat. What can we do? Plant native shrubs & trees! But more on that later...

Pest Free Dairy Flat was set up just one year ago. Initially, it was all about pest control but we quickly realised that the mission of bringing back native birds is much bigger than that. They will come and stay IF we can provide food, shelter and nesting sites. And that means native trees.



What have we achieved this year?

By 30th June, 6 months since receiving our first grant from Dairy Flat Community Trust, we subsidised the purchase of 142 traps. The community has reported 784 catches, which is a great start. *If they had remained alive, those pests would have bred to become over 100,000 within a year.* That's not an exaggeration but simply reflects how fast they breed.



Why do we need to control them? Because they eat birds, chicks and eggs. Because they consume vast amounts of native fruits and vegetation (not just the lemons in your gardens!). Unchecked, they prevent natural regeneration in our bush areas. It's not a pleasant task but we do need them gone.



What else have we done? We have understood that you can't create a community across 8000 hectares, so we are organising local 'hubs', each with their own priorities based on local needs. Some want to plant stream or wetland margins, some focus on pest control, others on growing seedlings. Yes, we are starting a virtual nursery across the area. If everyone grows a few seedlings every year...

Why plant natives? Apart from attracting native birds, native vegetation will help with erosion control, slip stabilisation, even carbon sequestration. An ocean is made up of drops, a forest of trees: every tree in the ground helps, so please have a think about your block and where you could plant a few natives.

With your help, we can restore our local environment and bring back more native birds to our backyards.

The Wainui and wider community are working together to address recent and ongoing dog attacks on livestock.

The episodes in our immediate area span over the same week. They have been brutal attacks with no sign of the killing's being intended for food. Livestock have suffered horrific injuries, killed, maimed, and left for dead with broken jaws, back legs and torn hides for their poor owners to find in the morning.

With the help of animal control DNA has been collected from one attack and is now on file.

As a community we are trying desperately to raise awareness of the facts surrounding such circumstances, we intend to hold a meeting at Wainui Village Hall (date to be confirmed) and address the following subjects;

- That animal control should be notified of attacks
- That animal control act swiftly
- That if called immediately DNA will be collected
- That by reporting attacks, or wandering dogs/sightings etc, information can be collected, area hotspots identified and animal control will target and patrol areas of concern
- That landowners are on high alert and if dogs are spotted on properties, landowners will and are within their rights to shoot to kill wandering dogs
- Dog owners must be responsible for where their pets are at all times to keep them safe
- We want to highlight the issues animal control have with overcrowding in pounds
- We want to highlight the red tape which hinders cases proceeding, with the focus on limiting the time these dogs are kept impounded
- We want to address insurance policies and what landowners are covered for

We are all animal lovers and don't want to see the suffering of any pet/dog alike.

We aim to have a representative from Council, Animal Control, Community Police, Local Reporter, Local Vet Clinic and FMG in attendance.

After learning that similar attacks are happening daily in our area we need to raise awareness, educate and form alliances to combat these horrific deeds. Eye witnesses are in no doubt that any animal large or small, cattle/horse, could be targeted, and fear children too could be at risk.

We are now a community that can't sleep, are out patrolling with spotlights at night and we're looking for support.

4/7 Waitoki Road, Wainui - night attack, cow herd chased through electrified fence, 2 ewes, 2 lambs, 1 ram killed/maimed needing to be put down. 4 lambs orphaned.

6/7 Pebble Brook Road, Wainui - night attack, 8 sheep slaughtered.

7/7 Haruru Road - 1 ewe, 1 lamb killed during daytime attack

11/7 Bawden Road - two dogs caught killing 4 ewes, seized by animal control

13/7 Greens Road Farm - dog caught in act during off lead walk, killed four ewes

Other details emerging of four attacks in Helensville in the same week.






